AFFIDAVIT OF VENESSA LYNN MARSH

COMES NOW, the affiant, VENESSA LYNN MARSH under oath, and hereby gives this her AFFIDAVIT for use in the above-styled case in the Superior Court of Walker County; and said affiant doth show that she gives this affidavit of her own free will and without coercion or undue influence from any other; and does swear as follows:

That my name is Venessa Lynn Marsh and that I reside in Walker County, Georgia; and

That I am employed at Blue Cross Blue Shield of Tennessee;

That I am paid every two (2) weeks, and my *weekly* net income is \$527.90;

That a copy of my two-week check stub is attached hereto as EXHIBIT A;

That since September 6, 1997 I have been married to Tommy Ray-Brent Marsh;

That we have one child, a daughter, born February 3, 2002;

That I have numerous monthly obligations and debt, and have attached a list of my said monthly debts as EXHIBIT B;

That I have two savings accounts and one checking account in my name only, and no joint accounts. I have attached a list of my individual bank accounts as EXHIBIT C;

That the monthly obligations listed are those I am personally obligated for, and do not represent any of the indebtedness of my husband, except for the expense for his electronic monitoring bracelet;

That to my knowledge, my husband has additional obligations for medical bills, past due state and federal taxes, two Visa accounts, and debt from the former operation of Marsh Vault and Grave. I have attached hereto a list of separate indebtedness of my husband that exists to my knowledge, as EXHIBIT D;

That I cannot afford to pay for any of the various legal costs (experts, etc.) that are needed for the defense of my husband, in that the issues have depleted our family finances and my income is needed to support our child and pay my monthly obligations. I do not wish to contribute toward my husband's legal expenses, although I love him and pray that one day this controversy will end for our family.


